

Meridian Breaks Ground on 84,000 SF Meat Processing Facility in Chicago

CHICAGO — Meridian Design Build has broken ground on an 84,000-squarefoot USDA meat processing plant for Amylu Foods in Chicago's Stockyards Industrial Park. The new sausage processing facility will include 56,000 square feet of production and cold-storage space and a freezer. The property will also include 16,500 square feet of corporate office space, including separate raw and cooked facilities, test kitchens and a laboratory. An expandable ammonia refrigeration plant will accommodate plant cooling and production loads. Harris Architects and Kimley-Horn make up the project team.
