MERIDIAN BREAKS GROUND ON KUBOTA ENGINE EXPANSION

LINCOLNSHIRE, ILL. — Meridian Design Build has broken ground on a 100,280-square-foot building expansion for Kubota Engine America in Lincolnshire. The project includes the construction of an 81,880-square-foot warehouse and 18,400 square feet of office space.
