

## Meridian Design Build breaks ground on 189,000-square-foot distribution center in Illinois

Meridian Design Build's national projects group recently broke ground on a 189,926-square-foot package-sorting and distribution center in Rock Island, Ill., for Indianapolis-based Scannell Properties. The facility will sit on a 29-acre site at Illinois-92 and Turkey Hollow Road.

The building will include 8,259 square feet of office space, 59 loading docks, 193 exterior trailer stalls and 160 van-storage positions.

Michael Winger, director of Meridian's national projects group, is leading the Meridian Design Build team. Precept Design, LLC is providing the architectural services on the project, while Shive-Hattery is providing the civil-engineering work.
