Meridian Design Build's National Projects Group was recently selected by developer Scannell Properties to coordinate construction efforts for a new 304,317 SF package and sorting distribution center on a 60 acre site in Pittston Township, PA.

The facility, being constructed on a build-to-suit basis for a leading provider of global shipping and information services, will include 99 loading docks, 238 interior van loading positions, 586 auto parking stalls, and 375 exterior trailer stalls.
